TEMPORARY ATTACHMENT – DAILY SOLUTION

STEP BY STEP: GLUE IN CLIPS

The hair system is only temporarily attached to the remaining hair by a temporary clip attachment. The clips can always be attached where the hair situation is intact. Long-term stress on the hair is avoided by regularly removing the hair system. Temporary clip attachment is the simplest form of attachment. Where sewing leads to damage to the base, gluing the clip is a good alternative.

Gluing makes sense wherever a base contains PU coating or sewing would lead to damage.

2

The Red Liner is applied to the desired clip as adhesive tape. This lasts for 1-3 days. If necessary, the white protective film is removed from the Red Liner for gluing.

3

The Red Liner can be cut to the desired size.
The red protective film remains on the adhesive strip. The pressure on the film is adhered to on the clip.

4

The red protective film is removed from the adhesive strip so that the clip can be glued to the hair piece.

5.

The clip is glued to the desired area on the hair piece with strong pressure. The clips open by fixing the edges and pressing lightly on the center.

6

Slightly tapping the hair in the fixing area of the clip increases the grip in your own hair.

7

The hairpiece is placed on the head at the desired location. By folding up the base and inserting the open clips into your own hair, the hairpiece is fixed.

8.

The locking mechanism is activated by lightly pressing on the outside of the clip. A slight click can be heard. The hair piece is additionally fixed to the hair by the processed silicone band. The hairpiece can then be integrated into the hair situation.
